Special flood forecast bulletin, Flood forecasting division, Department of Hydrology and Meterology (Nepali): Flood Risk in next 24 hours, where? (Unofficial translation): 1. Mid Terai's Saptari to Bara district, high risk mainly in the channels of river flowing from Chure (include rivers: Triyuga, Khando, Ratu, Gagan), medium risk in the channel of river flowing from Mahabharat (include rivers: Kamala, Bagmati) and low risk in the channel of river flowing from Himalaya region (includes: Saptakoshi) 2. From Nawalparasi to Banke, high risk mainly in the channels of river flowing from Chure (include rivers: Binaya, Arun, Tinau, Banganga, Jhinhari, Prabasotanala, Dunduwa), medium risk in the channel of river

flowing from Mahabharat (Tinau, West Rapti, Babai) and low risk in the channel of river flowing from Himalaya region (Karnali) 3. Water inundation increasing rapidly in Narayani River; 7.4meter noted in 7:00 am today. The warning level of Narayani in Devghat is 7.3 meter which doesn't seem to exceed till evening today. May cross the warning level after the mid night however will not reach the danger level. Hence, seems medium risk.4. Low risk in the flow of Koshi, Karnali and Mahakali, remains below the warning line. 5. Else, all rivers show low risk symptom.

Milijuli Nepali, Episode 680: In this episode, the presenters talk to the residents of Gorkha's Bhachek. In the conversation, the residents question the Deputy Chairperson of their Rural Municipality, Chandramaya Gurung, on what the local government's role and support will be in terms of the reconstruction scenario.

Reconstruction FAQs published in Annapurna Post on 16 June 2017: sourced from the [HRRP FAQs](#), the question included is: The government's plans and policies have not been clearly communicated to us and there is a lack of proper information flow regarding the housing reconstruction. How can we access more information?

Earthquake memorial park to be constructed in Barpak: A plan has been approved to construct an earthquake memorial park at Barpak, the epicenter of the April 2015 Gorkha earthquake. The Department of Urban Development and Building Construction (DUDBC) divisional office in the district has estimated the park construction will cost approximately 180 million NPRs.

[Number of missing children rises after 2015 earthquakes: Study](#): The number of missing children increased after the 2015 earthquakes compared to a year before the disaster, says a report recently published by National Human Rights Commission.

[NHRC report shows rise in human trafficking post-quake](#): a recently published report from the National Human Rights Commission (NHRC) indicates that human trafficking in Nepal has significantly increased since the 2015 earthquake. The number of reports of trafficking, or attempts to traffic is estimated to be around 23,000 Nepalis during the fiscal year 2015/16.

[Flooding affects over 100 families](#): fresh flooding has impacted villagers in Saptari on Wednesday. Bhediya and Mayanakaredi settlements have been most affected after floodwaters entered the settlements when the Mahuli river breached the embankment in five places. More than 100 families have been displaced.

[Development Committee directs Govt to give victims of natural disaster relief items immediately](#): At its 126th meeting, Development Committee(DC) under Legislature –Parliament has made a decision to direct Nepal Government, Home Ministry, Irrigation Ministry and National Planning Commission to collect relevant information regarding the damage caused by natural calamities such as landslide and flood that occurred recently in different parts of the country and the people who suffered from these natural disasters.

[Transfer of forest management rights protested](#): Foresters have protested the government's move to transfer forest management rights to the provincial level. The General Secretary of the Nepal Foresters' Association (NFA), Bishnu Prasad Acharya, said the government was attempting to dismantle forest-based organisational structures by limiting forest offices to provincial levels.

[Sand mining on the banks of Trishuli River \(in photos\)](#): People from Dhading, Banke, Bardiya, Dang, Kailali, Rolpa, Rukum, Salyan, Makwanpur, Bhojpur, Sankhuwasabha, Ramechhap, and Dolakha districts have moved to the Trishuli river bank in large numbers to take up work drawing sand from the river bed. The work is risky but the workers estimate that they can earn between 3,000 and 5,000 NPRs per day.
